Programs Requirements "Declaring Major" & "Change of Major" within the College of Engineering

Students who are interested to join one of the programs offered by the College of Engineering must fulfil the requirement of this program, whether if they are applying through the process of "Declaring Major" or through the process of "Change of Major" within the College of Engineering. These requirements are a way of assessing their academic abilities and ensuring they will be able to cope with the level of study in this program.

CENG Programs Minimum Requirements:

Architecture:

- Applying to Architecture program is only available for the Fall semesters.
- Students applying for the Architecture program must sit for the **Architecture Aptitude test** (APAT).

Chemical Engineering:

- This major is not available for students who have completed their secondary school certificate in the Technology track.

Computer Science and Computer Engineering:

- If the student has a GPA, then it should be >= 2.5.
- If the student completed GENG 106, then the grade should be >= B
