
"Early detection of oral potentially malignant disorders: current practice and future directions"

Associate professor of Oral Medicine, College of Dental Medicine, Qatar University

Dr Sadeq Al-Maweri is Associate Professor of Oral Medicine, currently serving as the Acting Department Head of Pre-Clinical Oral Health Sciences, College of Dental Medicine, Qatar University. Dr Al-Maweri holds MSc and PhD degree in Dentistry (Oral Medicine), with an extensive research and teaching experience.

Dr Al-Maweri has strong background in dental research, with over 100 publications in highly regarded Dental/Medical Journals. Dr Al-Maweri's research interests are diverse, including tobacco-induced oral mucosal lesions, oral cancer, oral microbiome, oral health in relation to systemic diseases, and evidence-based dentistry. In recognition to his impactful research contributions, he has been recognized among the World's Top 2% Scientists List of Stanford University for three consecutive years (2021-2023).
