This study examined the value of pharmacist diagnosis and prescribing for hypertension in the context of Australian community pharmacy practice. This study utilized a modeling approach to estimate the incremental cost-effectiveness of allowing pharmacists to initiate, monitor and titer BP control and examined the population impacts both at a health and monetary level.

Professor Carlo Marra started his career in Canada where he completed his BSc(Pharm), hospital pharmacy residency and PharmD at the University of British Columbia. He then completed a post-doctoral fellowship in arthritis pharmacoepidemiology and a PhD in health economics at the Arthritis Centre of Canada. He subsequently was a Professor at the University of British Columbia before moving to Memorial University and then the University of Otago where he was the Dean of Pharmacy for 10 years. He most recently has moved to Curtin University in Perth to be the Pro-Vice Chancellor of the Faculty of Health Sciences.
